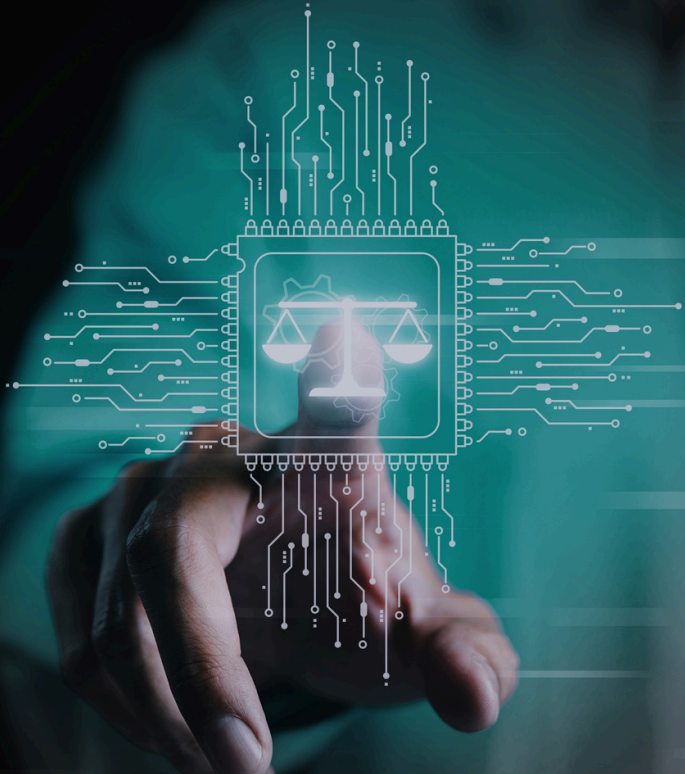


EUROPEAN HANDBOOK ON EQUALITY DATA

The Handbook is a shared reference tool that helps improve cooperation, consistency, and accountability among key actors—like CSOs, law enforcement, courts, and policymakers. Its flexible approach can be adapted to different countries while supporting a unified European perspective.





The Handbook helps key actors, such as CSOs, police, courts, and policymakers, collaborate more effectively and stay accountable. It can be adapted to each country while maintaining a shared European approach.

It also provides practical tools, like data indicators, common formats, and ethical guidelines, to support institutions in using data and technology responsibly, promoting inclusion, and combating discrimination across the EU.

At the same time, the Handbook acknowledges that implementation can be challenging. Differences in laws, limited resources, and cultural sensitivities, such as discussing race, religion, or sexual orientation, can make equality data collection difficult for some countries, CSOs, and local authorities.

The Handbook provides practical, adaptable tools to harmonize equality data across the EU. It supports EU and national policies, promotes responsible use of AI and OSINT, and helps turn data into a tool for inclusion and fairness, in line with the EU's commitment to fundamental rights.
