Strengthening Data Equality in Law Enforcement

22–23 & 29 June 2026 | Athens | 134 participants

As part of the DATA EQUALITY project, KMOP, KEMEA and the Hellenic Police jointly organised and delivered a three-day training for 134 representatives of the Hellenic Police.

Held at the General Police Directorate of Attica, the training provided participants with practical knowledge and insights on data equality, helping strengthen awareness and support fairer and more inclusive practices in law enforcement.

Participants explored the **European Handbook on Data Equality**, examining how data collection, management and exchange intersect with AI and OSINT tools, and what this means for promoting equality, non-discrimination and the protection of fundamental rights in law enforcement practice.

The interactive sessions also created space for meaningful dialogue, allowing officers to share first-hand experiences and discuss practical challenges related to the responsible use of data and AI in policing.





By combining their expertise, KMOP, KEMEA and the Hellenic Police translated the DATA EQUALITY project's research and tools into practical training, strengthening the capacity of law enforcement professionals to apply data equality principles in their daily work.

Across Italy and Greece, DATA EQUALITY's Cascade Trainings and law enforcement sessions are turning the project's research into practical tools for the people applying EU law every day.



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
